

Cut out and glue under tab. Then label.



Tropical

near the equator. One third of the world's largest rain forest can be found in Brazil. Other tropical rain forests can be found in Southeast Asia, the Pacific Islands and West Africa.

Temperate

along the coast in temperate zones. The largest rain forests can be found along the coast of North America from Oregon to Alaska.
