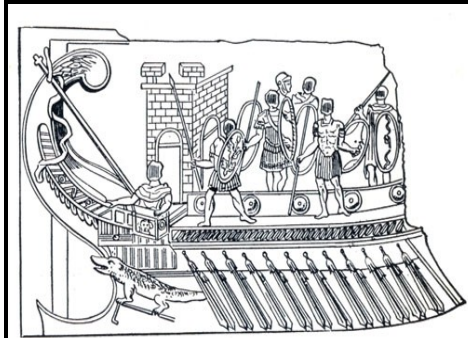


These books may seem a little trickier to fold, but they are not :o) They save you a step or two. Cut out entire book. The Step 1. Fold in half first on SOLID black line. With book facing up, fold left side back and under. Crease on solid black line. Step 2. Then fold in half again on the DOTTED LINE following the same method as Step 1 by folding the left side back and under. The title page will be on the front now and the book opens from right to left. Also, when you open the book, the pictures will be inside and on the left side. The right inside is blank. Add your own facts or use the book on the next page with facts added. *Note: After step 1, you may want to add glue to the inside of your book to make it more firm.*
