There are two ways to do this **one** book depending on the ages of your children or what you want them to do.


The first mini book (pages 2 and 3) has *information already on them regarding historic battles*. Simply cut, put in order from shortest to longest, staple on left side and glue to your page.


The two second mini book has just the pictures and your child can write their own text. (pages 4 and 5)











The surrender of the British General John Burgoyne at Saratoga, on October 17, 1777, was a turning point in the American Revolutionary War.





A miraculous convergence of American and French forces traps Lord Cornwallis at Yorktown, Virginia. He surrenders his British army.







