

The Different Colored Rivers of the Amazon

Black Water

After you cut out and with BLANK side of book facing UP, fold in left side, then right side.

Blackwater rivers originate in the lowlands. They flow through swamps and flooded forests. They are full of acidic soil and sand. They are the color of dark tea.

White Water

Cut through tabs to form three tabs. Tabs will open left to right to reveal info under it.

Whitewater rivers begin in the Andes Mountains. Whitewater rivers have lots of plant and animal life. They are a yellow color.

Clear Water

This part is the back and you glue here.

Clearwater comes from earth that is low, old and already broken down. Not a lot of minerals or nutrients are in these rivers. There is not a lot of plant life there.
