**What is a meridian?** A line extending from pole to pole that measures longitude.

**What is the prime meridian?** The 0° meridian from which all longitude is measured east and west. It passes through Greenwich, England, site of the Royal Observatory.

Latitude and longitude lines on a map form a **grid** that allows you to find any place on earth. Both latitude and longitude are measured in **degrees** and **latitude** is always given first.
