Note: After you cut out, it is easier to fold the creases BEFORE you cut between the tabs.

How to fold: With blank side facing up and cover on your left, fold columns/bottom up. Fold top down. They will meet but not overlap in the center. THEN cut between two pages to make three lift tabs. Use your own answers or use these facts.

For a lot of our minibooks we try to make them so that they can be used for both older and younger children.

If you have a younger child, simply cut off the top tabs for this year and then let them either draw what went on inside the temple or simply narrate to you what they know. In addition for a very young child, you can simply cut off all of the book except for the title page to simply show it is the Parthenon

The Parthenon is in Athens, Greece. It was built on the Acropolis. Athens is named after the Greek goddess Athena

Greeks built temples to honor their gods. The Parthenon is a temple built to the goddess Athena. It was one of the most beautiful and famous temples.

It is a hill. The Greeks built their temples on the highest point in the city and it was the Acropolis. They filled the Acropolis with beautiful statues of their gods.
