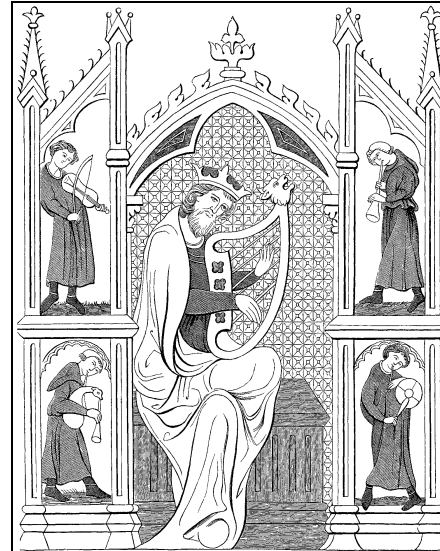
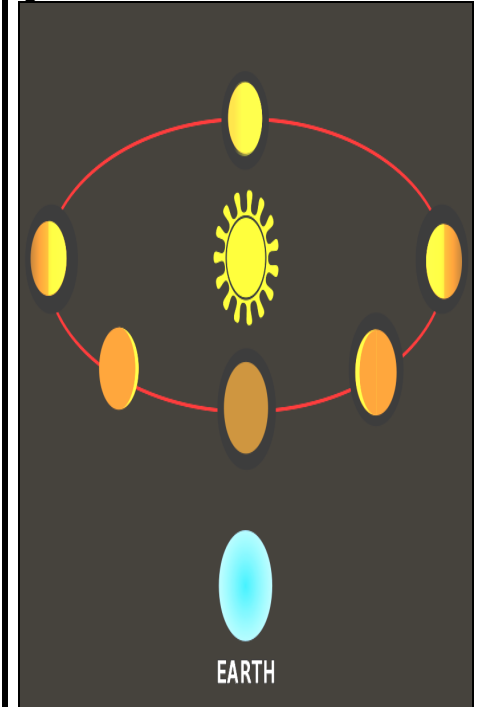


Fig. 49.—King David playing on the Lyre, surrounded by four Musicians.—Costumes of the Thirteenth Century (from a Miniature in a Manuscript Psalter in the Imperial Library, Paris).

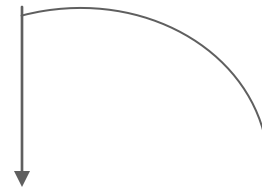
Literature

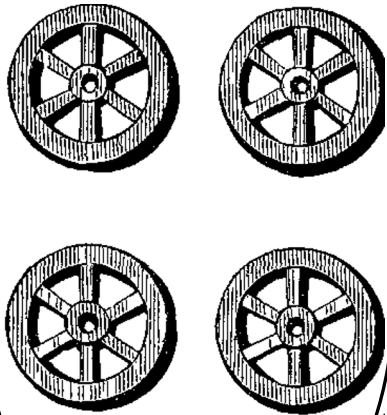
Art/Music

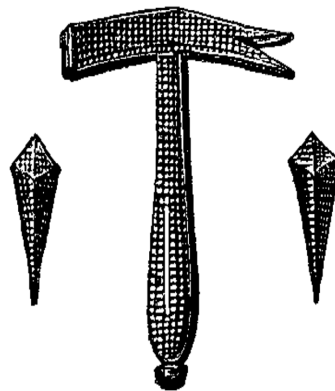

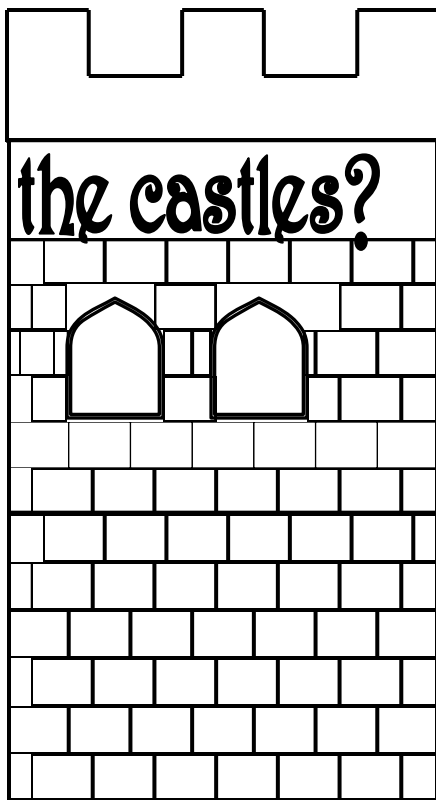


Nail Maker

Cut out as one, then fold front or the page "Boot and Shoe Maker" back, then accordion fold.

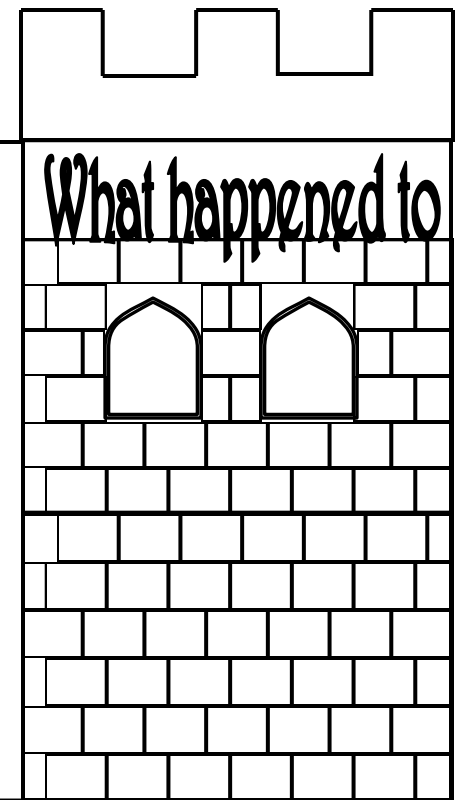


After you cut out, fold both sides in.

Castles

Castles were fast becoming obsolete.

Their original purpose was to protect the families. However, as peace set in, the castles were turned into stately homes for the noble. Castles were turned into palaces.

Housing of the Rich

Housing during the Renaissance was based on social class and money.

The very wealthy lived in manor houses or villas (country estate). Some of the palaces and villas were very luxurious. The floors might be made of marble and tile with ornate columns and *pilasters*. A pilaster is a decorative column built into the wall. Expensive drapes and carpet might adorn every room along with comfortable bed and perfumed linen.

Housing of the Poor

Housing was made of stone, wood or earth.

The floors of peasant cottages were made of packed dirt or tile. A mixture of hays, herbs and flowers would cover the floor to mask the odor.

- My famous work is *The Praise of Folly*.





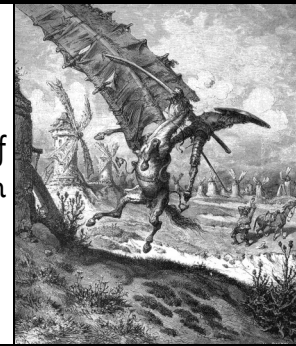
Name:
