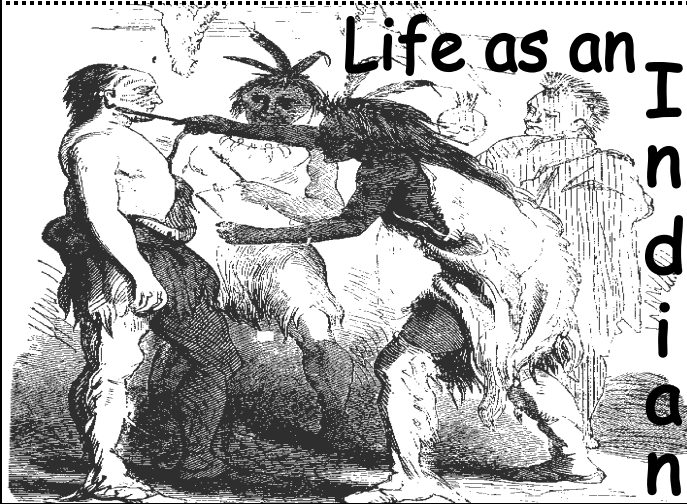


Flip book. Cut out and fold on dotted line. Use the facts given at the right or use the blank insert at the bottom to glue inside your book and write your own facts.

Three times Boone was kidnapped by the Native Americans. Three times he escaped. One time he overheard their plan to attack Boonesborough. Boone paddled in a canoe for about 160 miles in just four days to get the message of the attack to the settlers at the fort. He helped to save their fort. The Native Americans respected Boone's courage so much they decided to adopt him and not kill him. They painted his face in stripes with red and yellow clay, so that he looked, as they thought, handsomer than he ever had before in his life. They pulled out all his hair except one long lock, called the "scalp-lock," which they left to grow .
