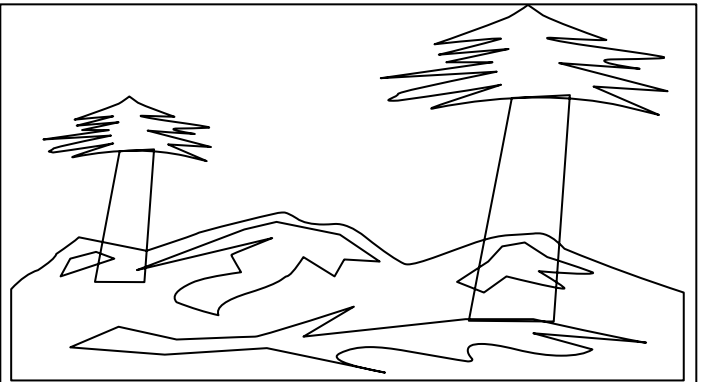
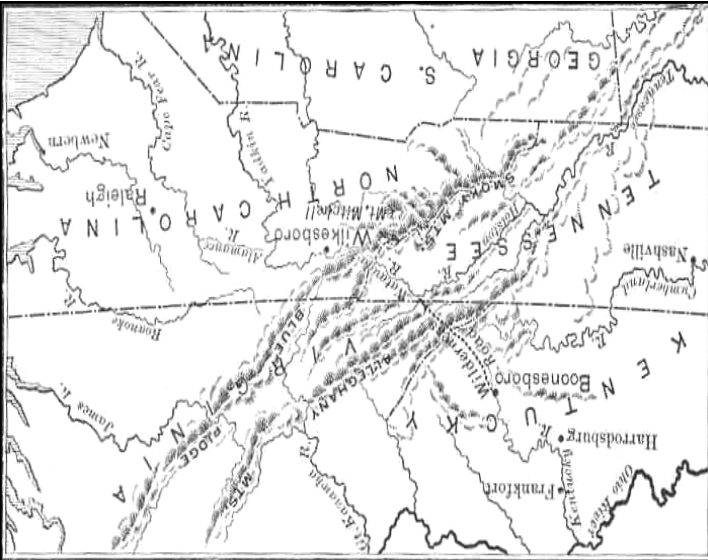


1. The Wilderness Road was an important gateway to the West. T or F.
