Identify and label plants—Pictures of plants from top to bottom, left to right are as follows:

1. Big-Head Clover (*Trifolium macrocephalum*)

Collected: 1806 Apr 17 - The Dalles, Oregon

2. Purple Trillium (*Trillium petiolatum*)

Collected: 1806 May 6 - Clearwater River near Potlatch River, Idaho

3. Lewis's Blue Flax (*Linum lewisii*)

Collected: 1806 Jul 9 - Sun River, near Simms, Montana

4. Salal (*Gaultheria shallon*)

Collected: 1806 Jan 20 - Fort Clatsop, Oregon

Bottom:

1. Bunchberry (*Cornus canadensis*)

Collected: 1806 Jun 16 - Eldorado Creek, Lolo Trail, Idaho

2. Lewis's Monkey Flower (*Mimulus lewisii*)

Collected: 1805 Aug 12, 15 or 26 - Lemhi Pass, Montana and Idaho

3. Salmonberry (*Rubus spectabilis*)

Collected: 1806 Mar 27 - Mouth of Cowlitz River, Washington

4. Shining Oregon Grape (*Berberis aquifolium*)

Collected: 1806 Apr 11 - Cascades of Columbia River, Oregon
