Titanic and her sister ship Olympic, owned by the White Star Line, were built to set new standards for luxury. They weren't intended to be the fastest but they were the largest. The first class accommodations included elaborate suites.

First class passengers could also enjoy a gymnasium, swimming pool, squash racket courts and Turkish baths.

Even the second class accommodations on Titanic were better than some first class on other ships. Third class passengers, most of them emigrants found plentiful food and accommodations more comfortable than anything they had previously known.
