

What is a carnivorous plant?

Carnivorous plants are plants that can absorb certain nutrients from animals they trap. All plants need nitrogen to live. Carnivorous plants can live in areas where there is poor soil and where nitrogen is not easily absorbed. So the plants do not eat the insects for food but digests the poor captured insects as a source of nitrogen. Some common carnivorous plants are venus fly-trap, bladderworts, pitcher plant and sundew.
