Option A (for child who wants to research)

Option B (for younger ones, or who prefer the image)

Cut either piece on the outside line and glue to the inside of your book. Then place glue on left side so that cover glues on.

Note: Remember that sometimes the physical distinctions or features can be blurred as this is not a scientific grouping. These are just common names. It is not uncommon to find a toad that is slimy or a frog that is warty.
