There are basically three books here.


Use the page above as a title page for two of the books for an older child.


For a younger child use the coloring page on here (right side only) for a younger child.

California Indians cherished the poppy as both a source of food and for oil extracted from the plant. It became the state flower in 1903.




Animals

The California grizzly bear was designated the official state animal in 1953. Before dying out in California, this largest and most powerful carnivores thrived in great valleys and low mountains of the state.





Products


California grows over 200 crops. Some crops include grapes, almonds, strawberries, oranges and walnuts.


