## **Activity Sheet Instructions:**

\*Coloring Media simply refers to your choice of things to color the project with...crayons, marker, paint, etc. Play the music that goes with each activity sheet while working on the projects. Card Stock is recommended for some projects for durability, but you may use regular white paper.

### **Reproducible 7-A – CREATION WHEEL page 1 of 2**

Materials: Copy on White Card Stock/ \*Coloring Media/ Scissors/ Pencil/

1. Color the letters and even the background. (Consider unique coloring crayons or even a heated crayon technique to raise the letters such as suggested in “Donna's Craft Corner Tips” pages.)
2. Cut out the wheel and poke a hole in the center with a sharp pencil. (May need adult assistance.)
3. Now you are ready to complete the page 2.

### **Reproducible 7-B – .CREATION WHEEL page 2 of 2**

Materials: Copy on White Card Stock/ Crayons/ Scissors/ Pencil/ Prong Fastener

1. Color the pictures.
2. Cut out the wheel and poke a hole in the center with a sharp pencil. (May need adult assistance.)
3. Lay page 1 circle over page 2 circle.
4. When the center holes line up, push a prong fastener into the pre-made hole from the front of the wheel.
5. Open the prong on the back of the wheel. (For the protection of the child, put a piece of tape over the pointed ends of the prong.)
6. The children may use the Creation Wheel during the song, “God Did” or at any time when they want to review the seven days of Creation.
